Four-time Emmy Award winner Jim Parsons (“The Big Bang Theory”) headlines an all-star cast in Mart Crowley’s landmark play. Premiering off-Broadway in 1968, it was a huge success and helped spark a revolution by depicting gay men’s lives onstage in a world not yet willing to fully accept them. Now, 50 years later, this comedic drama comes to Broadway for a limited 15-week engagement.

THE BOYS IN THE BAND revolves around a group of gay men who gather in an apartment in New York City for a friend’s birthday party. After the drinks are poured and the music turned up, the evening slowly exposes the cracks beneath their friendships and the self-inflicted heartache that jeopardizes their camaraderie.

Jim Parsons will be joined by Emmy nominee Zachary Quinto (“Star Trek,” “American Horror Story”), Golden Globe Award winner Matt Bomer (“The Normal Heart,” “Magic Mike”) and two-time Tony Award® nominee Andrew Rannells (“The Book of Mormon,” “Falsettos”). They will be directed by two-time Tony Award® winner Joe Mantello (“The Humans,” “Other Desert Cities,” “Wicked”).
