Academy Award nominee Uma Thurman (*Kill Bill*; *Pulp Fiction*) makes her Broadway debut in this “electrifying new power play” by Academy Award and Emmy Award nominee Beau Willimon, creator of “House of Cards,” and directed by Tony Award® nominee Pam MacKinnon (*Who’s Afraid of Virginia Woolf?*; *Clybourne Park*).
